

Living Waters Baptismal...

provides vibrant, flowing water which can be seen and heard, but with absolutely no splash. God referred to Himself as the *“fountain of living waters”* in Jeremiah 2:13, and Jesus told the woman at the well He could give her *“living water”*—a water that can become within the believer a well springing up to eternal life (John 4:10-14). Jesus declared, *“Let anyone who is thirsty come to Me, and let the one who believes in Me drink. As the scripture has said, ‘Out of the believer’s heart shall flow rivers of living water’”* (John 7:37b-38) NRSV. Baptism does not require flowing water, but the sight and sound of moving water offers a vivid reminder that the life of the believer is not intended to be still, but alive in Christ with the Holy Spirit and God’s grace always flowing from within.

Each baptismal is hand-crafted out of solid cedar, or oak and oak-veneered plywood, and custom finished in a variety of wood stains. Each baptismal is completely self-contained, requiring only to be filled with five gallons of clean water, and connection to a standard 110 volt outlet to be operational.

Baptismals can be operated in two modes, providing either a “Gushing Spring” water effect that creates the most visibility and sound, or a “Crystal Pool” effect with a smooth water surface and very little sound. There is no splash in either mode. Baptismal is available with optional underwater light, water heater, and solid cedar or oak lid.

Baptismal is designed to be completely safe, equipped with low voltage (12 volt) controls and lighting, and protected by an integral ground fault circuit interrupter.

Features

- ❖ **Cabinet** is solid cedar, or oak and oak veneered plywood, stained, and sealed with six coats of clear polyurethane.
- ❖ **Baptismal Bowl** is pure white porcelain ceramic with a solid brass inlet available in brushed nickel or oil rubbed bronze finish.
- ❖ **Pump** is food-grade stainless steel, powered by magnetic drive, separating pump from motor for absolute safety, and is rated for 15,000 hours of service.
- ❖ **Fan** built into cabinet is completely silent, eliminating heat and humidity.
- ❖ **Underwater Light** (optional) is low-voltage LED rated for 50,000 hours of service.
- ❖ **Water Heater** (optional) allows water temperature to be adjusted for comfort.
- ❖ **Controls** are low-voltage (12 volt) for safety, with a flush-mounted, illuminated on-off push button switch.
- ❖ **Locking Door** provides easy access to integral drain value and hose for draining and replacing water, or adjusting water heater temperature.
- ❖ **Leveling Casters** (4) make it easy to move and level the baptismal even on uneven floors. (Move and level before filling.)
- ❖ **Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter** is built into the standard 10 ft. long power cord, allowing baptismal to be completely safe from electrical shock when plugged into a standard 110 volt electrical outlet.
- ❖ **Lid with Cross** (optional) is solid cedar or oak with drip edge to prevent spillage if accidentally operated with lid on.

Options

- ❖ **Cabinet Material:** Cedar, or red oak are standard, but because these are custom built, other wood types could be available.
- ❖ **Cabinet Finish:** Clear or any standard wood stain can be requested and used, but stain color varies based on wood type, grain pattern, and other factors, so we cannot guarantee to exactly match any specific finish.
- ❖ **Brass Inlet Finish** can be provided in a choice of brushed nickel or oil rubbed bronze for no extra charge.
- ❖ **Power Cord:** Standard cord is 10 ft. long, but longer cords can be provided in 5 ft. increments up to 50 ft. maximum.
- ❖ **Underwater Light, Water Heater & Lid** are all considered “optional” because they are not necessary for the operation of the baptismal, and may not be desired by all churches.

Shipping

Baptismal can be shipped UPS, or delivered to destinations within a 100 miles radius.

Warranty

All material and workmanship are guaranteed for one year from date of shipment. Warranty is limited, and does not cover customer caused damage due to improper operation.
